Keokee, VA

Beulah Duff Bobrosky, 98, passed away on Saturday (Dec. 31, 2016) at Lee Health and Rehab Center in Pennington Gap, VA.

She was born on August 27, 1918 at Johnson's Mill, VA. During WWII, Beulah worked at a factory in Indiana, as part of the War effort. As the War ended, she returned to Southwest Virginia and finished getting her teaching degree from Radford University. She taught school at Calvin and Keokee. Beulah wrote and had two books published-"Leather Britches" and "Down Memory Lane"-books about Southwest Virginia and it's people. For many years, she wrote a weekly article for the Powell Valley News entitled "Crab Orchard." She co-authored, "The Village of Keokee." Beulah was very active in several veterans groups, volunteered for many years at Lonesome Pine Hospital and received many awards. In later years, she lived with her daughter, Linda.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 69 years, Paul Mike Bobrosky; her parents, Melvin Samuel Duff and Flossie (Hobbs) Duff; and her three brothers, Clarence Duff, Deward Duff and Dewey Duff.

Surviving are her daughter, Linda Wingfield and husband, Gib; two grandsons, Nathan Pope and wife, Andrea, and Joshua Pope and Sarah; great

granddaughters, Natalia and Allison Pope; and special friends, Ronald and Willie Richardson.

A mausoleum service will be conducted at 11 a.m. on Saturday (Jan. 7, 2017) at Powell Valley Memorial Gardens (5650 Powell Valley Road) in Big Stone Gap, VA with Rev. Alan Collier officiating.
