Raised in Appalachia, VA, Celia graduated from Appalachia High School in 1973 before pursuing higher education at Virginia State University, where she earned a Bachelor of Science degree in 1977. After briefly working for the Social Security Administration in Norton, VA, she returned to VSU to complete her Master's degree in 1984. Celia then settled in Petersburg, VA, where she began her long and successful career with the Department of Defense at Fort Lee (Fort Gregg), retiring in 2011 from the Division of Aviation and Logistics.

A woman of deep faith, Celia was a devoted member of Mt. Olivet Baptist Church, Petersburg, VA, where she served her congregation faithfully. Her commitment to service extended beyond the church, as she actively participated in community outreach, including preparing food boxes for the SHARE organization and care packages for local shelters.

Though she had no children of her own, Celia played a vital role in the lives of

her niece, nephews, and extended family, offering love, guidance, and unwavering support. She took great pride in being a Virginia State University alumna, regularly attending football games and alumni events and enthusiastically celebrating her beloved school.

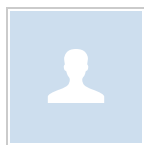
