Fannie Walker-Legge was born on March 7, 1927, to the union of the late Willis & Sophia Walker in Coaling, Alabama.

Fannie confessed that Christ was her Lord and Savior at an early age and became a member of New Asia Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend G.W. Sloan. Later in life she married William Knox Legge.

Fannie was initially employed as a substitute teacher in Coaling, Alabama. She then moved to Cumberland, Kentucky and worked at Mack's Café, which was owned by her uncle. After moving to Big Stone Gap, Virginia she met her husband, William Knox Legge and became co-owner and operator of Knox's Café in Big Stone Gap. Fannie was a member of First Baptist Church on Wyandotte Avenue in Big Stone Gap. She was known for her cooking and dressing with style.

Fannie closed her eyes and entered into heavenly rest on October 2, 2022, at Norton Community Hospital, Norton, Virginia.

Fannie was preceded in death by her husband, William Knox Legge, Sr.; her parents, Willis & Sophia Walker; son, Adrian Eugene Legge; stepson, William Knox “Bo” Legge, Jr.; six brothers, Raymond Moore, Wallace Walker, Walter C.
