Garner Allen Barker, 65, passed away Friday, March 9, 2018 at his home.

Garner was born August 17, 1952 to Julia and Elhanan Barker. He was a 1972 graduate of Powell Valley High School. He married his loving wife, Cathy, on November 7, 1973.

Garner was a former employee of Westmoreland Coal Co. and a recent retiree from Arch Coal. He was a member of the U.M.W.A. District #17, Local #1607.
