Lane, Helen L. "Peggy," 83, of Derby, VA, passed away on Monday (October 10, 2011) at her home.

She was born on August 28, 1928 in Stonega, VA. She was first employed with the Stonega Coke and Coal Co. in the payroll department at Stonega, VA, and later was employed by Dave's Department Store in Appalachia, VA for 24 years.

She was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church in Big Stone Gap, where she served on different committees and taught Sunday School in the children's department for over 25 years. She was affectionately known by most of the children as "Miss Piggy."
