Jimmy Ray Lomax, 83, passed away Friday March 29th, 2024, at Lonesome Pine Hospital, in Big Stone Gap, VA.

Jimmy Ray is one of four children, born to Fred and Bessie (Pierce) Lomax on December 25th, 1940, in Osaka, VA. He grew up in a home where there was always music. He was taught to play guitar by father, Fred Lomax, and continued teaching himself after his father's passing and taught himself to play the piano. Jimmy had a beautiful baritone voice and sang at places like church in youth programs and school functions. Jimmy Ray graduated from Bland High school in 1959 and sang "He" by Wintley Phipps during graduation. After graduation, Jimmy joined the Army and was stationed at Fort Jackson and later stationed in Germany. Jimmy then moved to Buffalo, NY, where he was employed by General Motors. Once retired, he returned to Big Stone Gap, VA.

Jimmy was preceded in death by parents, Fred and Bessie (Pierce) Lomax, and half-sister, Rebecca (Carl) Hale, brother, Richard Allen Lomax, and sister-in-law, Vivian Pierce.
