Lawrence "Larry" Jackson, 81, passed away on Saturday (July 30, 2016) at Lonesome Pine Hospital.

He was born on September 16, 1934 in Yorkshire, England, moved to the United States in 1967 with his family, and has resided in Big Stone Gap since 1983.

He was President of Westmoreland Coal Co., Treasurer of the Appalachia Cultural Arts Center, Treasurer of the Lonesome Pine Model Railroad Club, Board Member of Lonesome Pine Hospital, Committee Member of Wellmont Health System and a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Big Stone Gap.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Stephen and Faith (Skelley) Jackson.

Surviving are the love of his life of 59 years, June Jackson; two children, Karen Jones and husband, Don of Kingsport, TN, and Paul Jackson and wife, Barbara of Malabar, FL; two granddaughters, four great grandchildren and a great-great grandson; a sister, Mildred Spiers of Melbourne, FL; and several nieces and nephews.

The family will receive friends from 5 to 7 p.m. on Wednesday at Holding Funeral Home (17 E. 3rd St., N.) in Big Stone Gap. A Rosary Service will be held at 7 p.m. Wednesday at the funeral home.
