Pat Morris passed away April 26, 2016 in Bradenton, FL. Pat had a good and long life of 92 years. He was a generous, kind and sharing "gentleman."

Pat served his country as a gliderman in World War II, attended the Army Specialist Training Program at University of Maine, was in the Battle of the Bulge, and received the Bronze Star for "heroic and meritorious actions" for retrieving the wounded from the battlefield.
