June 29, 1934 - August 5, 2011

Hutchinson, Mrs. Sylvia Simpson, 77, of Big Stone Gap, VA, loving wife, mother, grandmother, and friend, departed this mortal life for her heavenly home in the wee hours of August 5, 2011, at her home.

The majority of her life was spent as a resident of Big Stone Gap, and she was a professional teacher. She earned her Bachelors' degree from Knoxville College where she was a member of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, and her Masters' degree from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University. She retired from Wise County Public Schools after 34 years of devoting her life and skills to children.

She was a life-long, devoted member of Mount Hermon Presbyterian Church where she worked in the Missionary Society and served as Elder and choir member. She was a troop leader of Girl Scout Lone Troop Number 1, the first Girl Scout Troop in Big Stone Gap. She was also a member of the Wise County Education Association, the Virginia Education Association, and the National Education Association. Sylvia was an excellent homemaker and care-giver to her father-in-law, her mother, and two of her aunts.
