Thomas Victor Cooper, age 72, of Daleville, Virginia, passed away January 6, 2020, at Brookdale Roanoke Memory Care Center as the result of Alzheimer's dementia.

Tom grew up in Keokee, Virginia, a coal-mining community in Southwest Virginia. He graduated from Keokee High School, and Carson-Newman College in Jefferson City, Tennessee. He taught and coached at Dryden High School in Dryden, Virginia for two years. His remaining working years were for Fraley's Inc., a family-owned coal mining business in Big Stone Gap, Virginia. He and his wife Connie moved to Fincastle, Virginia in 2009. His home church was Fincastle Baptist Church in Fincastle, Virginia.
