He was the youngest of seven children. In his youth he attended and graduated from Thomas Walker High School. During his high school days he played football, tennis, and was a member of the marching band. After high school he served the country honorably in the United States Army. Upon his return to civilian life, he attended and earned his degree at Lincoln Memorial University. He spent the following 20 plus years serving his fellow citizens in the medical field. His most recent employment was with White Rock Truss company. He truly appreciated the fine guys he got to know and work with at this job.

He achieved this by years of coaching and being instrumental with youth. He was a huge supporter of Thomas Walker and the community.
