Vicki Murray was born August 18, 1956 and was graduated to her eternal home this past Friday morning, August 23, 2024 at the age of 68. Vicki was the only child of Frank and Sandra Goff Murray, originally from Big Stone Gap, Va. The Murrays lived most of their adult lives in the Indianapolis, IN, area and were charter members of Thompson Road Baptist Church, the only church with which Vicki was affiliated for her entire life.

Vicki attended Indianapolis Public Schools, and following graduation enrolled in Butler University, majoring in elementary education, receiving her BS degree, and then graduating also with a Masters' degree from Butler. She was a teacher in the Indianapolis Public Schools for her entire adult life, spending more than 30 years of that time in IPS school # 34, specializing in teaching students with learning disabilities. Vicki loved her students, praying for each one and sharing the love of God

with them as often as opportunity allowed.

She served in various capacities as a volunteer Sunday School worker and teacher at Thompson Road Baptist Church, beginning in the kindergarten class, and moving up eventually to the teen youth department where she spent several years as an advisor to the TRBC youth. She loved her church and was always willing to assist wherever and whenever needed. Vicki worked diligently in learning how to play the piano so that when a pianist was needed in the youth group, or even in the main services, she was available.

Vicki loved the Indianapolis Colts along with her father, Frank. She was a "Daddy's Girl." She collected "Precious Moments" figurines. Vicki was seldom seen without her signature smile and something positive to say. Her love of people, of her Lord and of her church will be sorely missed.

A memorial service for Vicki will be held Tuesday, August 27, 2024, at Thompson Road Baptist Church, 1700 E. Thompson Road, Indianapolis, IN at 11:00 a.m. with viewing beginning at 10:00 a.m. after service she will be transported back to Big Stone Gap, VA by her longtime friend and funeral director, Michael Riebe.

She will be laid to rest beside her parents, on Wednesday August 28, 2024 in

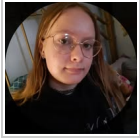
Glencoe Cemetery.
