He will be greatly missed.

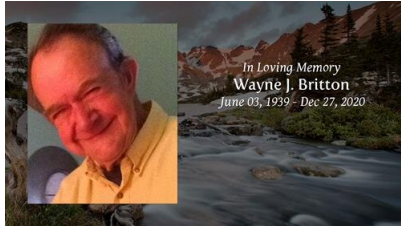
A private graveside service will be held Wednesday December 30, 2020 at Windridge Memorial Park in Cary IL.
